

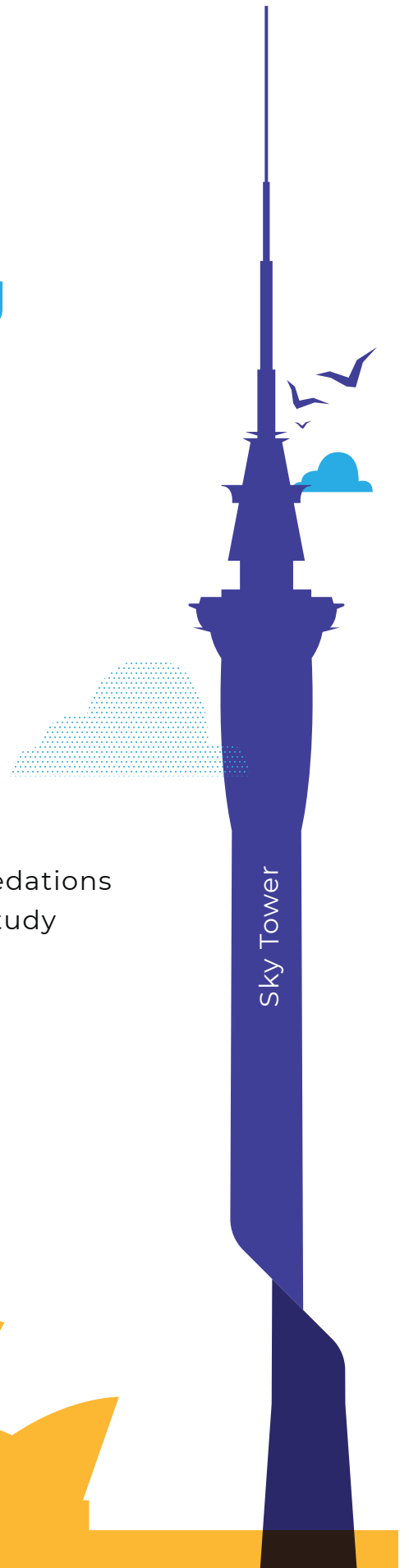

Australian Student Visa

Students seeking an Australian Student visa (subclass 500) need to apply using DIBP's online application system. The Visa application can be submitted 12 weeks before your course starts. The application fees is AUD 630 for the main applicant and for an additional applicant (above 18), it is AUD 470, while for under 18, it is AUD 155.

New Zealand Student Visa

Students desiring to stay in New Zealand for more than 3 months need to apply for a student visa. Visa applications are made via the nearest branch of the New Zealand Immigration organization or online. The application fee is NZD 330 and an additional amount of INR 955 for Center fee/Passport fee.

Accommodation

Australia Accommodation Can Be Split Into 3 Major Categories

On-Campus Dormitories :

Accommodations for students inside the campus. It costs around AU\$80 to \$250 per week, depending on the room size, amenities, etc.

Off-Campus Apartments :

Apartments located outside the campus that are rented by students. Living off-campus not only gives personal space but also helps gain valuable life experiences. It costs around AU\$100 to \$400 per week.

Homestays :

A unique student accommodation option where you reside with a homestay family. Students can enjoy all the home-amenities. It costs around AU\$110 to \$270 per week.

Part-time jobs for international students

The part-time job restrictions have been removed post COVID in Australia. Students are allowed to work full time as of now (this is a recent change and there is no clear idea whether it is temporary or permanent, but currently, the Australian government is following this rule).

New Zealand Accommodation Can Be Split Into 3 Major Categories

On-Campus Dormitories :

Accommodations for students inside the campus. It costs around NZ \$140 to NZ\$250 per week, depending on the room size, amenities, etc

Off-Campus Apartments :

Apartments located outside the campus that are rented by students. Living off-campus not only gives personal space but also helps gain valuable life experiences. It costs around NZ\$200 to NZ\$350 per week.

Homestays :

A unique student accommodation option where you reside with a homestay family. Students can enjoy all the home-amenities. It costs around NZ\$240 to NZ\$350 per week. Part-time Jobs -Students are allowed to work for up to 20 hours per week during term time and full-time during semester breaks. -Students earn a minimum wage of NZ\$16.5 per hour.

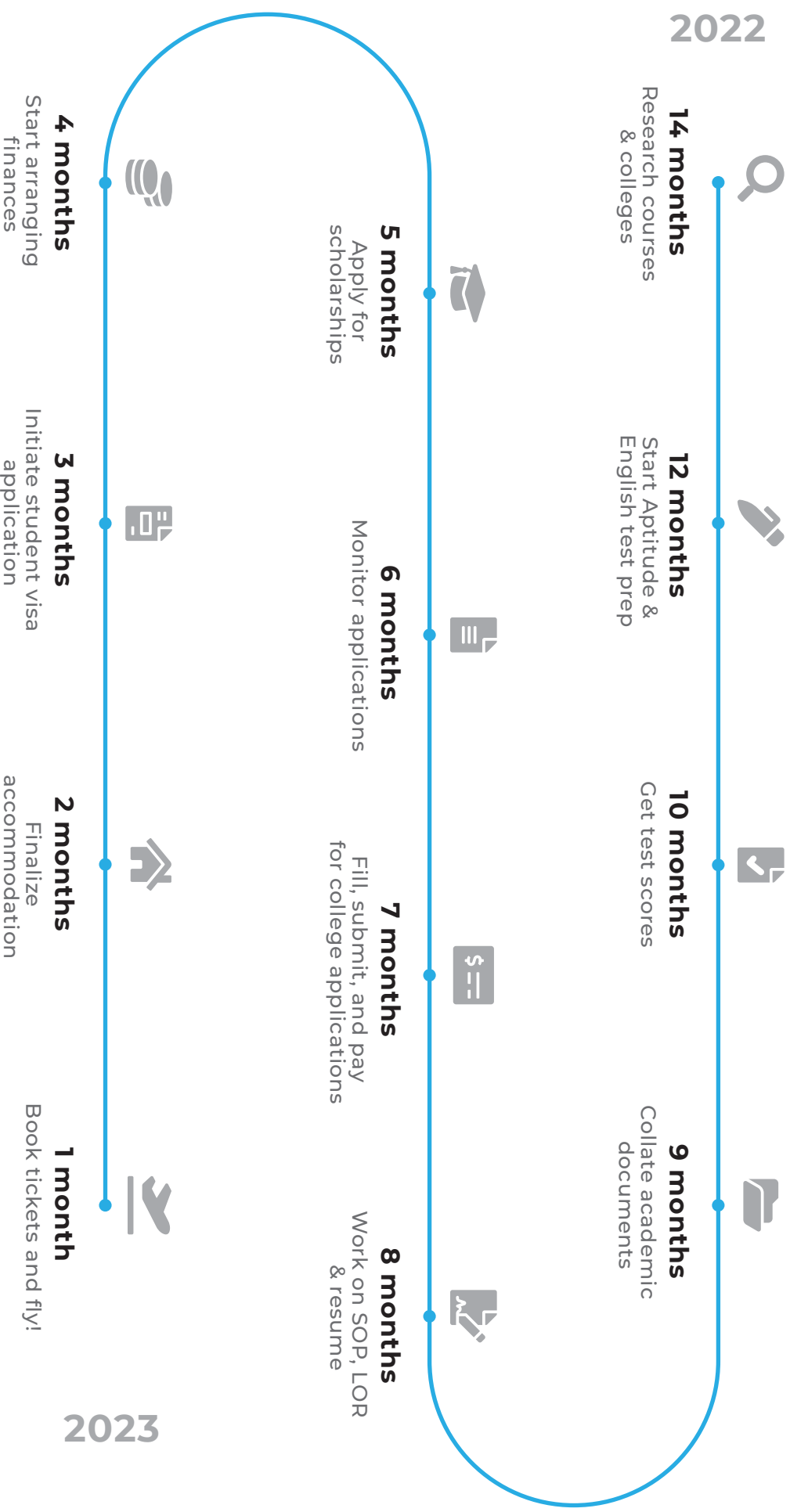

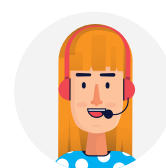
