

Types Of Accommodation

- **HOMESTAY** A unique student accommodation option where you reside with a homestay family. Students can enjoy all the home-amenities. The rent approximately starts from \$300 per month, and the total housing cost goes up to \$850 - \$950 per month.





- International students can enter the US in the form of an F-1 student visa or the M-1 and J-1 visas.
- Student and Exchange Visitor Information System is used to track and monitor institutions and exchange visitor programs and international students.
- The Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) manages international students in the F and M visa classifications.
- Department of State (DoS) manages Exchange Visitor Programs and international students on J visa classifications.


